COMPETITION RULES 2021



1. These rules apply to all internal competitions facilitated by Scarborough Camera Club, unless specifically stated otherwise.
2. All prints and digital images submitted in competition should not be more than three years old and be the original work of the competitor, who must be a current paid-up member of the club. For the avoidance of doubt, full metadata should be supplied with images. Any prints may be commercially or home produced.
3. Altered / manipulated images (colour or mono) shall be permitted in all sections, unless specifically stated otherwise. The work must be based on photographic images which are the original work of the competitor. An image may only be entered once, for example, the same image cannot be submitted twice, once as a colour and then as a black and white image.
4. For the purposes of the club's Kathy Underwood Trophy for Altered Images / Reality, members can draw from images older than three years for their composite image provided that these are all taken from their own work.
5. Any image that has been previously placed in an internal competition (1st, 2nd or 3rd) may not be entered again in a club competition. Any images may still be used in the year end-end competition and any external competitions or battles.
6. All entries submitted are done so at the owner's risk and no claim for loss or damage shall be made against the club.
7. The entry of a print or digital image shall be regarded as a declaration that it is eligible under these rules with which the competitor agrees.

8. Prints

On the back of each mount should be marked with your membership number and the title of your print. Mounts should be made of board or thick card and be no larger than 500 x 400mm. Glass mounted prints are not acceptable.

9. Digital images

Entries should be at a resolution of 96dpi and sized so that the longest edge has a maximum length 1600 pixels. The whole image must not be larger than 1600 x 1200 pixels, saved in a jpeg format at maximum quality (12). Images are usually about 1 – 2mb in size on average. Your image/file should be labelled with your membership number and the title of your image.
